## Dream on Amazing Challenge 2022 | Rules and Regulations |

### /1 DAM 2022

Dream on Amazing is a global challenge aiming to foster sustainability awareness and STEM-curiosity among pupils of 14 to 17 years old. DAM 2022 is an initiative co-promoted by Global Space Entities and sponsored by [Amorim Cork Flooring](#).

### /2 Who Can Participate

All pupils of 14, 15, 16, and 17-year-old enrolled in one of the 12 schools selected by the DAM 2022 Organization Team. Teams of 4 students from the same school (can be from different classes) will be required, and the first step will be to complete an application via form shown below.

#### /3 Phases of Competition

DAM 2022 is a 3 Phases Competition split into 2 Rounds to accommodate the different holiday schedules of participating countries.

#### /3/1 Phases of Competition – Phase 1 Country Representative Team is Selected

##### /3/1/1 P1 Teams Application

First step of the competition is to select one Team that will represent their country (12 Countries, 12 Teams).

(Round 1) Between 03.01.2022 and 16.02.2022 all teams interested per school from Germany, Switzerland, Belgium, the USA, Italy, Portugal, and Finland can apply by submitting a [via form shown below](#).

(Round 2) Between 03.01.2022 and 23.03.2022 teams interested from Sweden, Netherlands, France, Russia, and Canada can apply by submitting a [via form shown below](#).

### APPLICATION FORM

To be considered valid, an application must include the following requirements:

- \i Teams of 4 members, between 14 and 17 years old, enrolled in the same school
- \ii Application form submitted and considered valid
- \iii Signed Authorization to Participate

##### /3/1/1 P1 Country Team Selected

(Round 1) On the 17.02.2022 one Team per country will be selected from all approved applications [7 Teams will be selected].

(Round 2) On the 22.03.2022 one Team per country will be selected from all approved applications [5 Teams will be selected].

The criteria for selection will be:

\i Approved application

\ii Best Rating [1-10 Scale] on quality of application form submitted attributed by DAM 2022 Organization Team

(R1) On the 18.02.2022 before 11.59pm [Local Time] all Round 1 team candidates will be informed if they pass to the second phase or not and represent their countries.

(R2) On 22.03.2022 before 11.59pm [Local Time] all Round 2 team candidates will be informed if they pass to the second phase or not and represent their countries.

Also on this date, the selected Country Representative Teams will be put in contact with their matching Mentor.

### **/3/2 Phases of Competition – Phase 2 idea Design and Submission**

The second phase of the competition is **Designing the Sustainable Classroom of the Future** (cork is a mandatory material to use)

(R1) Between the 21.02.2022 and 11.03.2022 [11.59pm, Local Time] Round 1 teams will submit their idea via form shown below.

(R2) Between the 23.03.2022 and 10.04.2022 [11.59pm, Local Time] Round 2 teams will submit their idea via form shown below.

### **IDEA SUBMISSION FORM**

To be considered valid, an idea submission must fulfill the following requirements:

\i Idea Description (2 pages max + Annexes) attached to Idea Application form

\ii One Short Video with the team pitch [max 2 minutes, MP4 or MOV-file, not exceeding 0,5 GB of size.]

\iii Include Cork as a sustainable material

\iv Idea Application form submitted and considered valid

Please note the procedure and tools teams and mentors use for collaboration is their own decision but remote collaboration is recommended if country health authorities provide that recommendation. Mentors shall help with their experience only and are not expected to take the lead or give direct or indirect instructions.

### **/3/3 Phases of Competition – Phase 3 Winners Revealed**

(R1) Between the 14.03.2022 and 18.03.2022 the DAM 2022 Competition Jury will analyze and evaluate the phase 2 submitted and approved ideas from Round 1 teams.

(R2) Between the 11.04.2022 and 12.04.2022 the DAM 2022 Competition Jury will analyze and evaluate the phase 2 submitted and approved ideas from Round 2 teams.

DAM 2022 Jury will be constituted by 16 members: 3 Representatives from Global Space Entities and 13 Green Architects and Designers. This Jury will select the 3 competition winners from the approved submitted ideas.

The criteria for selection will be:

\i Approved idea submission

\ii Best Overall Weighted Average Scores [1-10 Scale] attributed by the Members of the Jury.

The Jury Evaluation will follow the below criteria

For the above evaluation, Jury Members will receive 12 idea descriptions, 12 short videos and 12 executive summaries from the teams.

On the 13.04.2022 DAM 2022 Organization will calculate the competing ideas scorings and identify the winners. The 3 winners will be publicly revealed on the 15.04.2022.

#### **\4 Other Notes**

**\In case of multiple deliveries, the last deliverable will be judged.**

**\No late deliveries are accepted**

**\Mentors are University students enrolled into architectural studies or closely related fields.**

**\The presentation of ideas in Phase 2 will happen exclusively via the submitted form, no synchronous presentation will happen. All pupils in the respective team will have to take a role in the short video. Teams are encouraged yet not obligated to distribute the video participation equally between the participants of the team.**

**\The jury consist of 13 members of sustainable A&D-studios from the countries which participate in the competition and 3 Representatives from Global Space Entities**

**\Each one of the 3 winning teams will win a trip to Portugal to visit Amorim Cork Flooring Headquarters, and their Schools will win a Mars inspired cork flooring (up to 33 square meters) applied in one of the classrooms.**

**\This initiative is exclusively focused on the promotion of knowledge and creativity of the participating teams. All Jury Members, Mentors, Co-Promoters and Participants will not promote or engage in any political, geopolitical, or other non-knowledge specific matter.**
